In an emergent meeting of the academic council held on 21st July 2012, the NDTF AC members-A. K. Bhagi, Anurag Mishra, Monica Misra and V.S. Negi took firm stand on the issue of Meta colleges/Meta University and submitted a note:

1. Such issues should be brought in regular AC meetings and not in emergent meetings. (The due process must be followed.)
2. University of Delhi should collaborate only with institutes of repute in keeping with the interest of students in terms of academic standards and fee structure. (To discourage privatization and commercialization of higher education.)
3. Future plans given in the Meta college document should be dropped. (To discourage online foreign university courses and accreditation.)

The above safeguards are necessary for keeping a check. An amendment was accepted, approval will be accorded by AC, on a case by case basis. NDTF members also raised the issue of permanent appointments in DU.

DUTA

It has been almost a year since the present DUTA team took over the charge. It is time to make an honest assessment and take necessary corrective measures to strengthen the movement. When the present team took over, the university was plagued with some burning issues, viz, the after effects of semester struggle and related court case, service conditions of teachers (especially promotion scheme), permanent appointment in colleges and university departments, poor medical scheme, poor house building advance scheme, filling of reserved posts and many more. However, we find that little has been achieved on these issues. No doubt the DUTA is run by all the stakeholders and different groups of the university teachers but the main responsibility is that of the group which is leading. In this case, the DUTA president belongs to DTF (CPM) and other office bearers belong to INTEC, UTF, and SSM. It is highly unfortunate that the office bearers did not get a single audience with the VC of DU: Many issues that could have been resolved at university level are still lingering on. It is not only the Delhi University VC who is insensitive to the collective voice of teachers but equally deplorable is the manner in which the MHRD has responded to our issues.

Do You Know?

All ad hoc teachers as per the EC resolution of 2008 are eligible for medical facility from the health centre and casual leave and earned leave.

Government's Role

The education policy of the GoI is moving increasingly towards ad hocism at all levels.

Some of the pertinent questions are:

1. How many colleges have been opened in Delhi by the central government or Delhi government in the last so many years in spite of an explosive increase in the population of Delhi? NONE.
2. What happened to the Central Universities opened by the GoI? Are they really functional? How many appointments have been made in these universities to make them functional? What about the funding of these universities?
3. Why the teaching and non teaching positions are not filled in Delhi government maintained polytechnics and schools? Why innumerable no. of teachers are working in these institutions for years now on contractual basis.
4. When the government is so keen to clear the six retrograde bills on higher education to promote commercialization and bring in foreign universities, what steps the government has taken to strengthen the existing educational system?

The government is working aimlessly and in an ad hoc manner. It wants to withdraw from the higher education in the name of education reforms. They make spurious claims on expansion in education. If the situation does not improve

quickly our education system will be rendered obsolete. DUTA has not played any significant role in opposing the six bills on 'reforms' in education pending in the parliament. It is important we launch a unified struggle against these retrograde bills.

Ad Hocism in Delhi University

More than 3500 teaching positions of DU colleges and departments are lying vacant and university sponsored ad hoc arrangement against these posts is in operation. For the first time in the history of Delhi University such a situation has arisen because of non-action on the part of Delhi University administration. The teachers are forced to work on ad hoc basis as there is an unwritten ban on the filling of teachers post on permanent basis. Because of this our young teachers are made to suffer and many more are discouraged from joining this noble profession. Annual increments, HTC/LTC, proper medical facility etc. are denied to young colleagues who are the future of our university. Many a bright careers are being destroyed under the shadow of uncertainty. This, of course, to some extent shifts their focus away from the teaching-learning process. NDTF is of the firm opinion that such an ad hoc environment is derailing the very foundations of the teaching process.

NDTF demands, therefore, that the process of regular appointments be started immediately and all those who are serving this university must be confirmed on their position from the initial date of appointment.

Exploitation of ad hoc teachers: to add to the miseries of the teachers working on ad hoc basis, many colleges are holding interviews even for continuing them in the ad hoc capacity w.e.f. 23rd July, 2012. Owing to the non-action of the university, many teachers are forced to continue in the ad hoc capacity for many years. Now interviews held in some colleges have added to their uncertainties. Many ad hoc teachers may even be ousted. What is the DUTA leadership doing?

Service Conditions of Teachers

It is the first time in the history of pay revisions that there is an inordinate delay in the implementation of service conditions of teachers. The sixth pay commission has been implemented only in terms of pay and there is a total chaos in regard to the anomalies removal, promotion scheme and other service conditions.

It is noteworthy that whenever the MHRD/UGC announces the pay revisions for teachers as per the pay commission reports there is a tendency of the government to tinkle negatively with the service conditions of teachers. It is unlike the positive treatment that is given to central government employees (class A and B). There were retrograde service conditions proposed by the MHRD along with pay revision. When the teachers objected to the proposed point system (PBAS), the MHRD and UGC were in no mood to revisit it. Only when the university administration raised doubts about its rationality and posed questions about its implementation did the UGC setup a

committee to have a relook at the document on service conditions. Till date nothing is clear about the date of announcement and changes incorporated on demand of teachers. Only after the notification by UGC the university amends and formulates the relevant ordinances. This means that even if UGC notifies the revised service conditions this month, the scheme cannot be implemented for at least the next six months or more- the time taken by the university in making relevant amendments in the ordinances. This delay would cause not only a monetary loss to teachers but will also negatively affect their academic progress.

Professorship in colleges: DUTA should launch a militant campaign to introduce quota free professorship in all colleges.

Education Reforms

For a university to progress appropriate reforms must take place at the appropriate time. This should be a continuous process and consensus must develop among the academic community to make necessary changes through debate and discussion. It is unfortunate that the present government and university officials have the least tolerance and patience towards the viewpoint of teachers. The present government has turned a deaf ear to the teachers' concern on the proposed reforms. This has led to a total destruction of the academics. It is worth recalling here that during the semester struggle, the government simply washed their hands off and called it internal matter of the university. The government is furthering its own agenda of privatization of higher education. It is now an open secret that the government is interested in a university system prevalent in foreign countries with a view to ease the entry of foreign players in India. There are certain very dangerous higher education bills lying in parliament. These bills, if passed, shall adversely affect the system. The NDTF has tried to intervene in this matter. Shri Prakash Javedkar and other MPs on the Parliament's Standing Committee have been approached by the NDTF to make them aware of our apprehensions. When these bills were discussed in the Parliamentary Committee and newspaper advertisements were issued, the DUTA office bearers never approached the MPs with objections on these bills. NDTF is not shying away from its responsibility but we feel that it was the duty of AAD and DTF (former and present presidential groups) to respond to such crucial events in time.

The DTF, though on paper, in staff rooms and in meetings, are opposing the reforms but they are soft on the government. In the last one year, the DUTA leadership has organized only one half day dharna at Jantar Mantar as an action program against the proposed bills. AAD and INTEC are openly siding with the government and the university to implement the so called "reforms" without debate and discussion.

Meta Colleges and Universities

It is very difficult to accept or reject any new concept. The same is true for 'Meta colleges and Meta universities' project as well. With all its inherent benefits and drawbacks there

can be a divided opinion on the issue whether the Meta university project would be feasible or not. Whether we accept or reject, it should be done through proper debate and discussion, formulating appropriate academic arguments on both sides. The very concept of resource sharing can not be negated only on the basis of ideological arguments. The apprehension that this concept may lead to the mixing of government funded universities and private universities thereby forcing students to spend more on a higher fee structure for earning few credits cannot be ignored. Here the economically weaker section of the society may be at a disadvantage which is not acceptable for inclusive development.

Another apprehension stems from the fact that since the private (engineering and management) institutes/ college/ university concept in India has not taken off well this might be an attempt for the government to prepare these universities for a public private partnership. This concept may also become a boon for the foreign universities which are looking for an opportunity to dominate the Indian education system. We must remember that on one pretext or the other many foreign universities (small players) have already entered into the Indian education system through private universities and institutions. Recently UGC gave a go ahead to 100 foreign universities to establish their centers in India. This is significant in view of the fact that the foreign university bill is pending in the parliament and there is no mechanism to regulate them. This move of the UGC and the government will create pressure to accept foreign university bill so that at least there is some regulation for the foreign universities. NDTF is of the opinion that if we can insulate our system from the dangers of the adoption of meta universities and meta colleges by saying no to resource sharing among unequals (in terms of fee structures) and allow for an initial pilot project amongst only the government funded universities and institutions, then a proper examination of the feasibility is possible.

CCL: Our women colleagues are put to great difficulty to avail of the Child Care Leave (CCL). The problem arises because the CCL is clubbed together with 10% quota (cap) for EOL and study leave. This effectively results in denial of CCL. The NDTF demands that there should be exclusive provision for CCL not linked with EOL or study leave. Teachers should get the same easily without condition.

Other Issues

There is a long list of demands under the DUTA's charter of demands 2011-2013. Unfortunately very little has been achieved on these demands. There is a need to build pressure through DUTA movement on the university officials/ UGC/ Delhi government/ the MHRD to achieve our goals. We urge upon the DUTA leadership to take a fresh look at the charter
